## **Required Academic Foundation in the Liberal Arts**

Prospective teachers must have earned a bachelor's degree with a <u>major area of concentration</u> that consists of at least 10 courses (30 credit minimum) above the introductory level which demonstrates in-depth study in one of the following fields: (1) Humanities; (2) Fine arts; (3) Social sciences; (4) Mathematics; (5) Sciences <u>or</u> (6) an Interdisciplinary major comprised of no fewer than 10 courses (30 credit minimum) with at least 5 from the same field and the majority, six or more, of the courses above the institution's introductory level in the other fields listed in (1) through (5) above.

Prerequisite coursework may be required if an individual's academic preparation does not contain enough depth or breadth in the liberal arts.
